 You CAN physically bolt up a truck bell housing to ANY V-8 Chev engine and also b the housing. BUT, here is the problem. That big hole in the housing is what center: input shaft with the crankshaft (**NOT** the 4 bolts which attaches the tranny to the h hole in the truck housing is TOOOOOOOOOOO big for a car tranny such as a Muncie, 5sp, Super T-10, etc. So, that is the main reason why you DO NOT want to use the housing. The possible result of not having the tranny properly centered can be acc and/or damage to both the tranny and clutch as well as the pilot bushing in the en
